It is also our chance to remind them that WE DO THE WORK of the state. If you have never attended, it is inspirational seeing all our Brothers and Sisters, from throughout Council 5 together, holding our legislators accountable for their actions. There is no need to be nervous, you do not meet with legislators alone; we go in groups.

Local 4001 has a goal of 100 members to attend Day on the Hill.

There are buses that come from several areas of the state, so if you are interested in this option, you could possibly get on one of the buses (information available on the Council 5 web site). If you want to drive yourself, the local will pay your mileage. We also pay your lost time for the day.

- 1:30 PM Rotunda Rally
- 1:45-4:15 Capital Lobbying
- 5:00-7:00 PM Reception (RiverCentre)

Just a follow-up: The Supreme Court has heard oral arguments in the Janus vs. AFSCME lawsuit and we are now waiting for them to make their decision. Let's not rest, we need to keep talking to our coworkers.
