By now I am sure that you have heard both the House and Senate have passed the frontline worker pay and Governor Walz signed the bill. The link below provides information about the application and submission for individuals to be considered for the frontline worker pay.

It is my understanding there will be a 45-day window to send in your application. If an individual is denied, I believe you will have 15 days to appeal. At the end of the 60 days the total fund of money available will be divided by the number of people eligible and the max you will receive would be no more than \$750.

As more information becomes available, I will share it with you.
